Please Note: Large size toiletries are difficult to ship and hard for the soldiers to carry on patrol and store.

Small, Travel-Size items are ideal!

- Toiletries:** Eye Drops, saline nasal spray, Tylenol, Tums, toothbrushes/toothpaste, antibiotic ointment, body wash/show gel (preferred over bar soap), body/foot powder, shampoo, skin cream/lotion, travel baby wipes (no large plastic boxes please), bug repellent (Off Deep Woods Towelettes)
- Personal Items:** White or black socks, eyeglass repair kits, CD's, DVD's, small games, puzzle books, blank CD's, dark hair elastics, dark bandanas, hand and foot warmers, batteries (all sizes)
- Snacks:** Beef jerkey, Slim Jims, raisins, granola bars, nuts (small packs), sunflower seeds, trail mix, small cans of fruit, tuna, instant oatmeal, powdered drink mix **singles**, hot chocolate
- Most Requested:** AT&T International Calling Cards, cards and letters of encouragement, drawings and cards from children.
